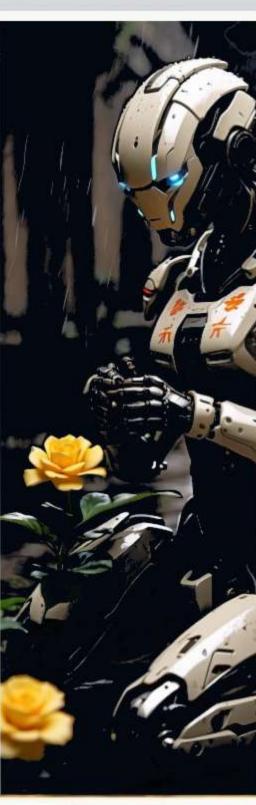

- Papers must follow MLA (9th Edition) formatting guidelines.
- Submissions should be in Word (.doc/.docx) format.
- All submissions must be original and should not have been previously accepted for publication in any other journal, or presented in any other conference/Seminar.
- The details of authors should include Name, organization to which affiliated, email address and mob number and must be included after the title of the paper.
- For the papers with more than one author, all the authors have to register individually to receive the certificate of paper presentation.
- As the conference is in hybrid mode, paper presenters can opt the mode at the time of filling up registration form. (Only presenters from outside Trichy district may use the online mode)
- selected papers will be published as conference proceedings with ISBN
- All papers will be subject to a peer review process.
